1. Collection: Donation booths were set up across Nashik, and over two days, members and citizens came forward to contribute generously.
2. Segregation: Volunteers gathered to sort, pack, and prepare the donated materials with care.
3. Donation: The collected items – including 15,000+ clothes, Classroom fans, groceries, blackboards, footwear, racks, toys, stationery, shoes, Shoe Racks, 3 bicycles, and seating mattresses – were distributed in Chimanpada village, Peth.
